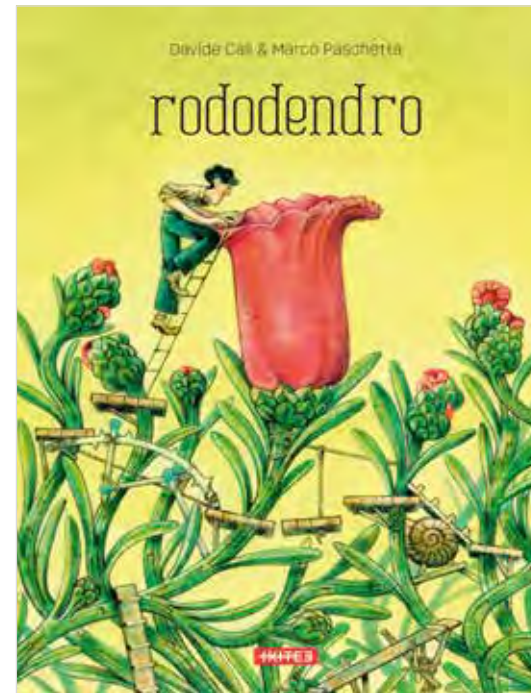
THE LITTLE MUSICIAN

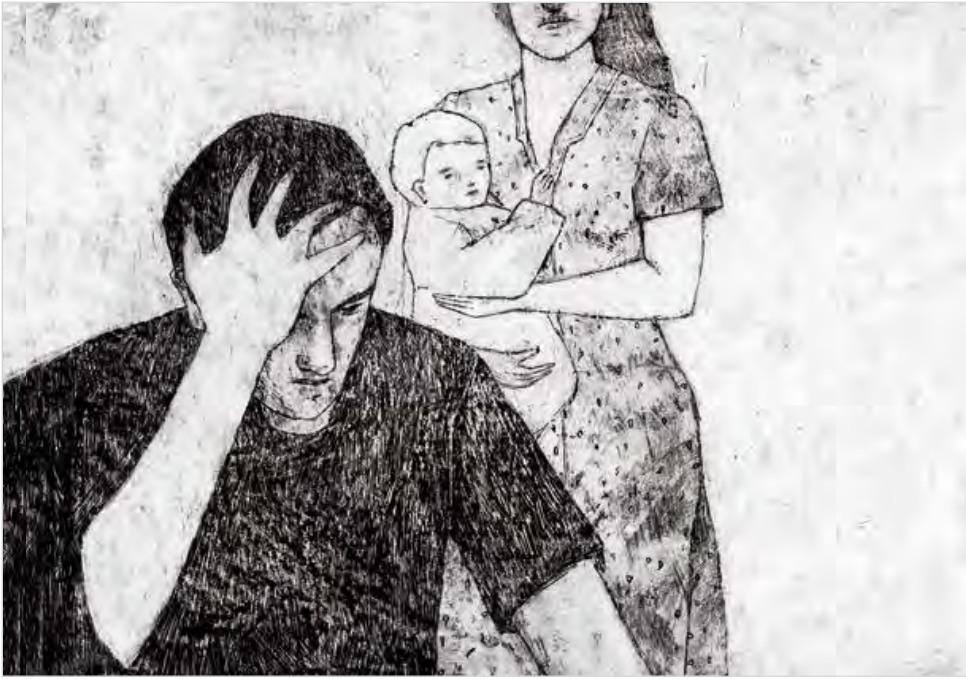


THE WOOD, THE GIRL AND THE WOLF
